



NOTICE OF COMPETITION FOR A STUDY AWARD TO THE BEST DOCTORAL THESIS ON INLAND AREAS

Art. 1

Eligibility criteria

The University of Molise issues a notice of competition for awarding 1 study prize to the best PhD thesis in 2021. The prize is worth € 1.000,00 and it is funded by Centro di ricerca sulle Aree Interne e gli Appennini (AriA) (*Research Center on Inland Areas and Apennines*).

To be eligible for application, candidates must have defended their final thesis during the period between **1st November 2020 to 31st October 2021**.

The disciplinary sectors of reference shall cover the following fields: agriculture and forestry, environment, law, economics, social studies, medicine, literature, history, cultural heritage, infrastructures and territory in relation to inland areas.

Art. 2

Application for admission

Candidates shall submit their application by using the form in Annex 1 to the certified email address: amministrazione@cert.unimol.it before the mandatory deadline of **15 November 2021**, under penalty of exclusion.

Applicants shall thereby declare, under their own responsibility:

- a. Name, surname and address;
- b. Date and place of birth;
- c. Fiscal code;
- d. The score obtained for the achievement of the PhD;
- e. To be compliant to the eligibility criteria referred to in Art.1
- f. To be informed that the data provided will be used pursuant to EU REGULATION 2016/679 and to allow their treatment

Applicants shall attach the following documents to the application form:

- 1) PhD thesis in pdf format;
- 2) the copy of a valid identification document;
- 3) information pursuant to art. 13 of EU REGULATION 2016/679 for the consent to the processing of personal data (Annex B) duly filled in and signed.



Art. 3

Selection Committee and final ranking

The selection Committee is composed of three faculty members with competencies in the field of inland areas and is appointed by the Rector according to the proposal put forward by the ArIA scientific board.

The selection Committee will assess the candidates according to the following criteria:

- Score obtained for the achievement of PhD;
- Originality/Innovation of the researchers presented in the doctoral thesis;
- Impact of the results illustrated in the doctoral thesis on the scientific field of reference;
- Relevance of the results illustrated in the doctoral thesis to the field of inland areas.

To each of the criteria listed above will be assigned a maximum score; the final score is given from the sum of all scores obtained from the assessment of each criteria, and will be accompanied by a short evaluation of the candidate.

On equal merits, priority will be allocated according to date of birth and the youngest one shall prevail. (art. 3, comma 7, l. n. 127/1997).

The prize will be awarded by Rector's Decree and assigned to the winning candidate at the University of Molise.

Art. 4 Responsible for the administrative procedure and personal data processing

Pursuant to art. 4 of Italian Law no. 241 and subsequent amendments, the individual responsible for proceedings is the Director of *Coordinamento Servizi agli Studenti* of the University of Molise, Mrs. Maria DELMEDICO.
